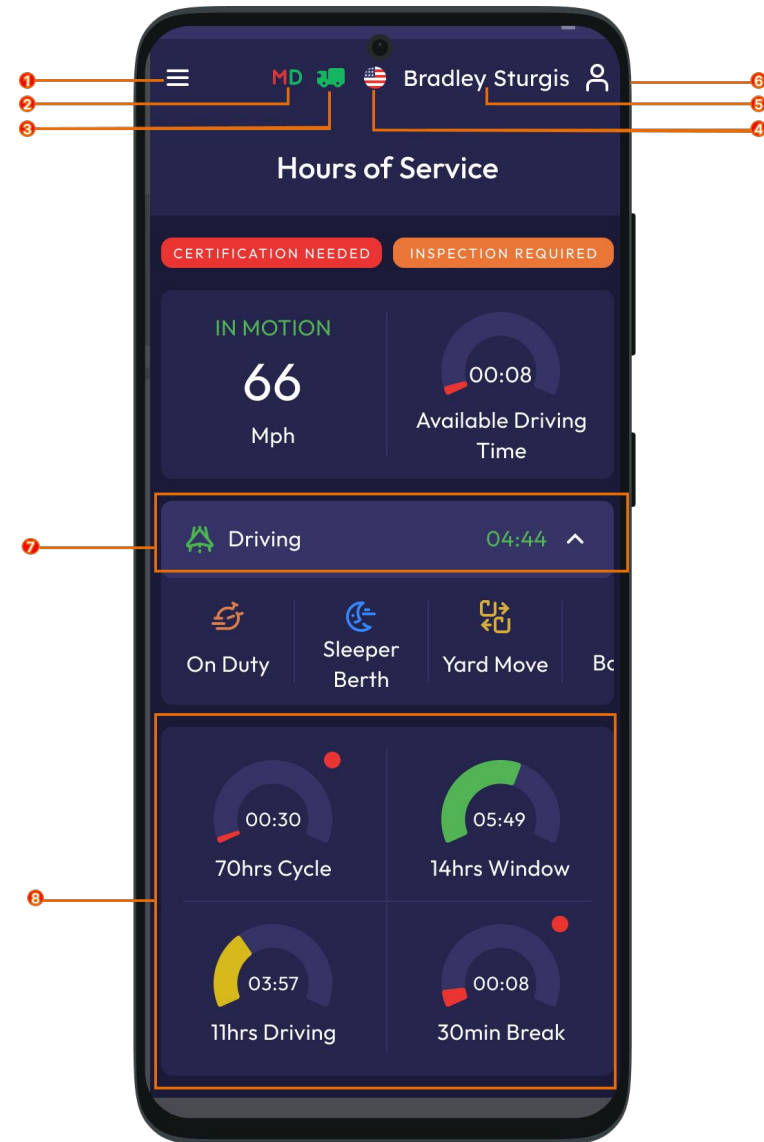

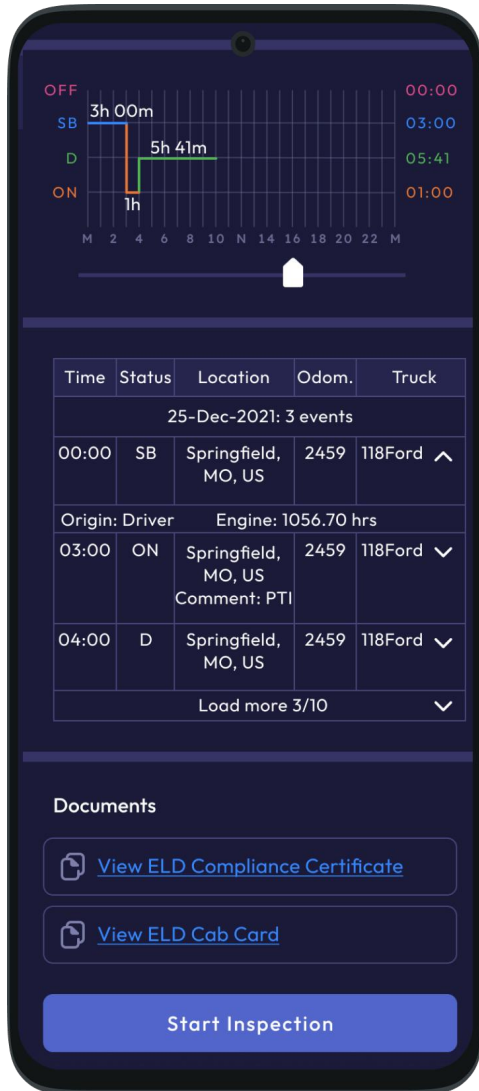

DOT Inspection Instructions

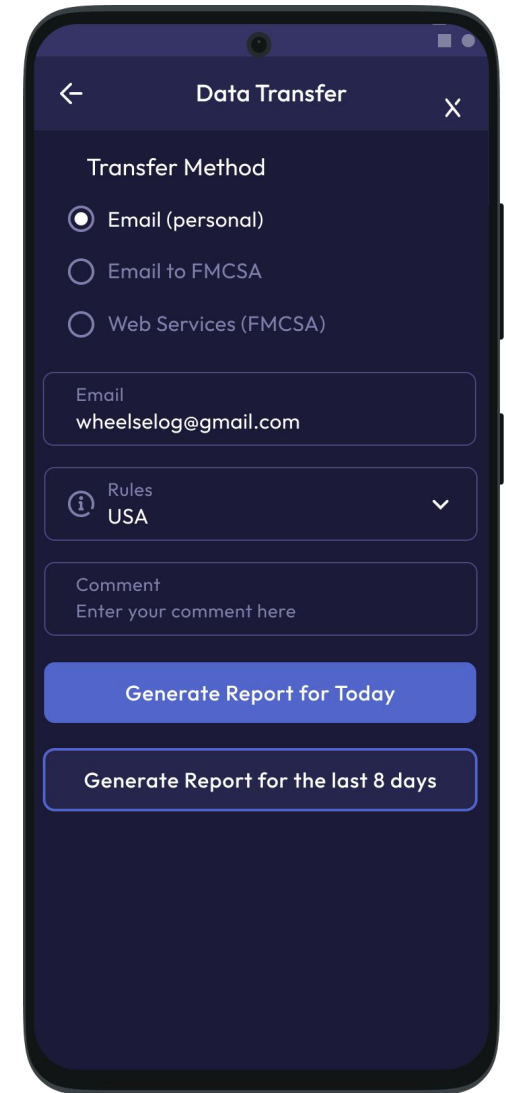

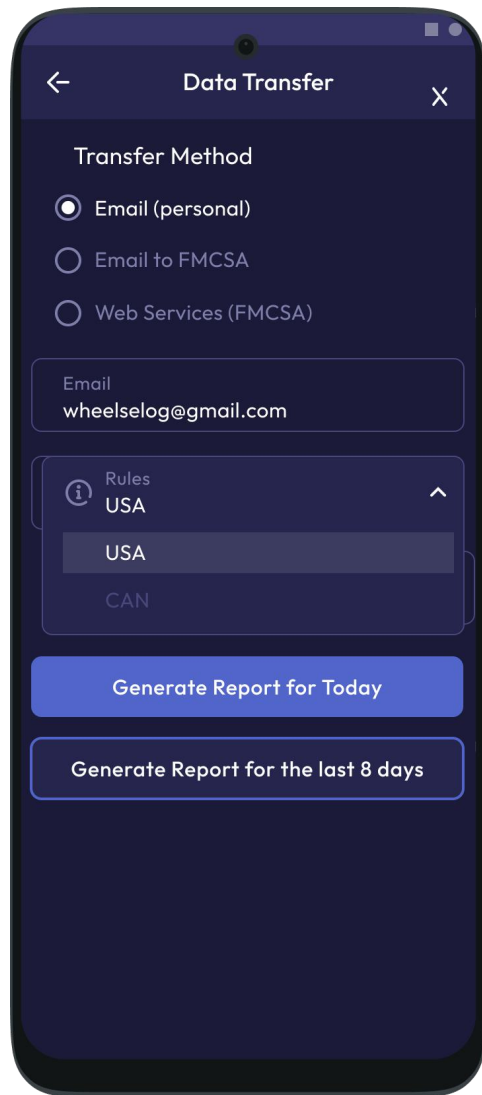


The **“DOT”** menu provides summaries of all the collected data about the driver, truck, and trip. Use this menu to transfer the data to FMCSA during the **DOT inspection**.

Click on the **“Start Inspection”** button and check if your logs are ready to be transferred to the safety officials. If everything is OK, click **“Transfer to Police”** and choose the method of sending your logs:

- send it to the Personal Email;
- send it to the FMCSA Email;
- send it to the Web Services (FMCSA).





If you select **“Personal Email”**, you need to:

- enter the recipient’s address,
- select the rules of the country in which you operate,
- and add a comment.

If you select **“Web Services (FMCSA)”** or **“Email to FMCSA”** you need to add a comment.

Please pay attention that during the DOT inspection, you will see the list of all drivers operating the same truck for the past eight days.
